¹⁹ HETTINGER.—Acme, Ashby, Baer, Brittain, Campbell, Cannon Ball, Castle Rock, Clark, Farina, Havelock, Kern, Merrill, Solon, Tepee Butte, and Wagendorf townships organized from unorganized territory since 1910. Villages incorporated since 1910: Regent from part of Indian Creek township and Mott from part of township 134, range 93. New England city incorporated from part of New England township since 1910.

²⁰ KIDDER.—Townships organized from school townships since 1910: Atwood from Arlington; Crystal Springs from Crystal Springs; Pettibone from Lakeside; Robinson from Lincoln; and Weiser from Malcolm. Baker township organized from Baker school township and part of Pleasant Hill township. Tappen township returned as a school township in 1910. School townships organized from other school townships since 1910: Barton and Robinson from parts of Merkel; Mahin from part of Quincy; and Tuttle from part of Norway.
