

Joseph A. Arpagaus, of St. Paul, who had been employed on the Ed. Zimprich farm, near Jessie, this fall died from a stroke of apoplexy Saturday evening. He returned from the field and had washed in preparation for supper, and while waiting for the meal to be served he played with the children, when he was suddenly stricken and fell to the floor, dead.
