

GAS EXPLOSION CAUSES DEATH

**Allison Bowe, of McVille, Succumbs
to Burns Received When Gas
Lamp Exploded.**

Binford people were shocked Tuesday afternoon to learn of the death of Allison Bowe, of McVille, a former resident here, from burns sustained from a gasoline lamp explosion. The accident occurred Monday evening while he was engaged in pumping air into the lamp, and the explosion was so terrific that the room was ablaze in an instant. The front of Allison's clothes became saturated with gasoline and before the flames could be extinguished, parts of the clothes were completely burned, inflicting fatal burns on his body. Mrs. Bowe was in the basement at the time of the explosion and probably because of this fact, her life was saved. In assisting her husband she received severe burns about her face and hands.
