where he enlisted in the Marines, not waiting to be called. He was sent to Paris Island, S. C., where he received training as a sharpshooter, until in May, when he landed overseas the 12th.

Two weeks ago his parents received a letter dated Sept. 26, from their son, who was then recovering from wounds in a hospital. It must have been upon his return to the front soon after that he made the supreme sacrifice for his country.

Besides the parents, there are two

hrothers, one of them in the service, and seven sisters, who are sorrow stricken at this sad news, and the sympathy of the entire county goes out to the relatives in their bereavement.
