Mrs. Martha Helland was born May 12, 1873, in Stavanger, Norway. She came to this country in 1892, and was married in December 13, the same year to Arndt Helland. Eleven children were born to this union, of which ten are left to mourn the loss of a kind and loving mother. Jonas, the oldest son, died of spinal meningitis in France, in 1918, while in service. The local post of the American Legion is named in his honor.

Mrs. Helland had been a sufferer from cancer for about a year. Twice she was taken to hospitals in Minneapolis and Fargo for treatment, but nothing could be done for her, and she passed away Saturday morning, after a long, busy and useful life.
