

Mrs. Anna Laatvedt Dead.

The death of Mrs. Anna Laatvedt occurred Monday night, Aug. 25th, at the home of her daughter, Mrs. S. N. Koloen, with whom she had made her home this summer. The immediate cause of her death was heart failure.

Deceased was born in Telemarken, Norway, in 1842, being 77 years old. She came to America about 40 years ago, and has lived on a farm in Pilot Mound for the last 30 years. Her husband, Ole Laatvedt, died in 1899.

Five daughters, all married, are left to mourn her death. They are, Mrs. S. N. Koloen and Mrs. Edwin Thorn, of near Binford; Mrs. Osmond Pederson of Mervin, Canada; Mrs. John Knapp of Cando, and Mrs. Artnur McColm of Opheim, Montana. A brother, Halvor Ambrosen, of Thompson, Iowa, also survives her.

Funeral services will be held at the home of S. N. Koloen, Saturday, Aug. 30th, at 2 o'clock, in the English language, and later from the West Prairie church where services will be conducted in Norwegian by Rev. Bach.
