Friday, to Peter S. Lyle, who resides three miles east of Sutton, coveyed the news that his son, Robert Park Lyle, was killed in action in France on July 15th.

No other information is contained

in the message announcing his death but it is believed here that young Lyle was among the casualties of the first days of the allies counter-offensive in the Rheims-Soissons salient.

Robert Lyle was about 23 years of age and was living with his parents when called in the selective draft. He left with the Griggs county contingent of 34 men for Camp Dodge.

This is the first casualty reported from among the boys from Griggs county, who are in service overseas.
