

## Axberg Kills Two More.

Lieut. Ed Axberg, of Enderlin, the pilot who, while flying at Sutton failed to come out of a tail spin and crashed to the ground killing his passenger, Brian Karr, had another serious accident at Hitterdal, Minnesota, last Wednesday, where he was giving exhibition flights and taking up passengers. In making a landing he collided with a school bus and Clifford Lonnsdal, 8 years old, and Elsie Moe, 14 years, are dead, and several others injured as a result of the collision. Axberg was making his landing between some buildings on the outskirts of town and right in the path of the approaching bus. Seeing that a collision was inevitable, Axberg turned the plane suddenly upward but it was too late. The tail caught the sleigh full of school children, turning it over with the above result. Axberg and the plane were not damaged.
