

Rev. Sweger's Mother Dead.

Although in failing health for some time, the death of Mrs. Mary A. Sweger, at an early hour last Thursday morning, gave a shock to her many friends. Mary Ann Stevens was born on Round Prairie near Viroqua, March 4, 1853, and taught for four years in the rural schools of this county. She was married to August J. Sweger, December 25, 1874, living a year at Springville, and then at Avalanche, where her husband was in business. Mr. Sweger died February 4, 1885, and the widow dealing in general merchandise until 1894, when she took up her residence in Viroqua, where she remained until the final summons.
