

Robert Widlund Dead.

The many friends and acquaintances of Robert Widlund, who resides between Binford and Cooperstown, were grieved to learn of his death which occurred at 5 o'clock last Thursday afternoon. The whole family was ill with influenza at the time, and Mr. Widlund, while taking care of the others and keeping up the fires, in his weakened condition, couldn't withstand the disease with its complications.

Robert Widlund was born in Sweden, and was the son of Mr. and Mrs. L. Widlund. He came to this country in 1891. In the fall of 1910 he was married to Miss Ida Gunderson, to which union three children were born. Following an illness of eight days he died at the age of 45 years.

Besides his wife and three small children, deceased leaves to mourn his death, his parents, six brothers and three sisters.

The funeral service was held at the home, Sunday, where a number of friends had gathered to pay their last respects. Rev. T. E. Sweger, of Cooperstown preached the sermon, and the remains were taken to the Cooperstown cemetery for interment.

Two brothers of the deceased, Isadore, of Grand Forks, and Bert, of Hawley, Minnesota, were here to attend the funeral. On account of sickness in their own families the others were unable to be present.
