

Dr. Amidon Accepts Professorship.

Wimbledon News: Dr. R. S. Amidon, veterinarian of this city, has been elected to the faculty of the Agricultural college at Fargo where he is to report for duty about September 1. The Fargo Courier-News in reporting the changes in the faculty of the college has the following to say regarding Mr. Amidon:

"Dr. Roger S. Amidon, formerly a student of North Dakota Agricultural college and a graduate in veterinary science of Ohio State university, was elected assistant professor of physiology and pharmacology of the school of veterinary science."

Dr. Amidon, when interviewed by the editor of the News, stated that he expects to leave here about June 1. He will go to Chicago and take a postgraduate course during the summer preparatory to his work at the agricultural college.

He has been here about two years and has developed a fine practice in that time. Dr. Ralph Cusac, now veterinarian at Courtenay, will succeed Dr. Amidon as veterinarian here.
