

DRUG STORE WAS ROBBED

**Thieves Enter Anderson's Pharmacy
Friday Night and Steal \$100
—No Clues.**

Thieves entered Anderson's Pharmacy last Friday evening and carried away about \$90 in currency and silver.

Entrance was gained through a basement window in the rear of the store. Indications point that there were two in the party. Footprints in the mud bear out this belief.

The thieves evidently were acquainted with the "lay of the land." After gaining entrance they went leisurely about their work. The cash which they obtained was in the register. They also looked into the safe, but overlooked a pouch containing a liberty bond and some currency. The show case doors were opened but nothing was taken from them. James Glaze, clerk at the store, first discovered the robbery when he opened the store Saturday morning. He was also the last one in the store Friday evening and when he entered the store in the morning and noticed the bottles and glasses on the counter he immediately suspected that something was wrong as he or Mr. Anderson are not in the habit of leaving their work half finished. Further investigation revealed the cash register opened and the money taken and the back door ajar.

No clues to the perpetrators of the robbery have been learned.
