One thing positive which they do know is that they want their mill

and toted away over the prairie to Aneta. According to reports made to the capitol at Bismarck the Sharon mill has been appraised at about \$15,000. The Aneta company is said to have provided from its \$60,000 capital \$12,000 for promotion and \$14,000 for the moving of the mill, leaving \$34,000 for operating purposes.
