

NEW GARAGE FOR BINFORD

**Erection of Building Will be Com-
menced as Soon as Weather
Will Permit.**

Binford is to have a first-class auto garage, and construction work on the building for the new enterprise will be started in a short time.

The promoters are H. B. Hanson, a local citizen, and Jesse Benton, of Finley. In speaking of the enterprise, Mr. Hanson stated to The Times that it is their aim to erect a building large enough for storage purposes, and still have ample space for the repair department.

It is planned to remodel the front room of the electric light plant, and to that an addition of 64 feet will be built on the west side, making an 80-foot front. Cement floors will be laid throughout, with drainage gutters to carry away the waste water and refuse when cars are being washed. Facilities for hot and cold water will be installed, as well as heat when needed.

A full equipment of the latest machinery and tools have been purchased.
