

NEW CLUB PRES- IDENT IS CHOSEN

E. E. IVERSON SUCCEEDS A. H. OVERBY AS HEAD OF COMMUNITY CLUB.

Feeling that he was unable to devote the time and attention to the office of president of the Binford Community club, A. H. Overby tendered his resignation, and E. E. Iverson was elected to fill the vacancy, at a meeting held in the opera house last Saturday evening.

The meeting was in the nature of a hurry-up affair, and, that coupled with the busy season, kept the attendance down. A few important matters, such as adopting a set of by-laws was introduced and passed upon with a few exceptions, to be taken up later.
