Reports which are considered practically complete shows that the membership to the Red Cross in Binford for 1920 numbers 105. A few straggling memberships will be likely to come in from time to time but the local campaign is considered practically closed. The record made by Binford this year, although not as nigh as the past year, is considered very very good, as the report indicates that the hundred per cent family membership goal to which the committee aspired at the beginning of the drive has been nearly attained.
