

TWO GRADUATE IN CLASS OF '20

COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES TO BE HELD AT OPERA HOUSE FRIDAY EVENING

Winford will hold the first commencement in the history of its school this year, when a class of two have completed a four year's course and will graduate from the high school. The exercises will be held in the opera house, Friday evening, June 4th, at 8 o'clock.

The speaker for the evening is Prof. John W. Ballard, instructor in the school of business at the University of North Dakota. The subject of his address is "Education and Business."

The graduates are Inez Greenland and Ivar Knapp. The class motto is "The End Crowns the Work." The class colors are green and white and the class flower the red rose. Inez Greenland has been designated as valedictorian, and Ivar Knapp as salutatorian.

An interesting program has been prepared by the teachers and pupils of the school in connection with the commencement exercises. Several good songs will be rendered by the pupils.

All parents and friends of the school are extended a cordial invitation to attend the program at the opera house.

Rev. T. E. Sweger gave an inspiring message to the members of the 1920 class in his sermon at the baccalaureate exercises held in the Lutheran church, Sunday evening.

Rev. Sweger took his subject from a bible scripture and advised the students to avoid indifference toward their moral and religious responsibilities in life, and when they have adopted an ambition, to serve it for the betterment of the world and not for personal advancement. To keep clean consciences and clean minds, and to be loyal servants of Jesus Christ was the substance of Mr. Sweger's advice to the graduates.
