

SCHOOL OPENS NEXT MONDAY

**Teachers Will Return Saturday From
Enforced Vacations to Resume
School Work.**

After an enforced vacation of more than four weeks, Young America of Binford will arise at an unusually early hour next Monday morning, wash their faces, shine their shoes, eat a hasty breakfast, and gather up their books to again take up their daily grind of school work.

The Binford schools, which have been closed since the epidemic of influenza became prevalent more than four weeks ago, will open again on Monday next, for their regular sessions and the teachers will all be back by that time to take up their duties.

Because of the fact that the influenza epidemic was something beyond human control and that the schools were closed through necessity the teachers have received their salaries for the time lost.
