

Cooperstown Honors Baldwin.

Cooperstown observed the passing away of its mayor, A. M. Baldwin, last Friday afternoon, when his last rites were performed in the auditorium of the gymnasium under the direction of the city council and the commercial club.

Mayor Baldwin died in Fargo at the Nelson sanitarium on Wednesday morning. He had suffered for six months with inflammatory rheumatism, but about three weeks ago left his bed. On his way to New Mexico, where he hoped for full recovery of health, he succumbed, at Fargo, to an attack of bronchial pneumonia, which his feebled condition could not resist.

The gymnasium-auditorium was appropriately decorated with the national colors and an innumerable number of flowers. Music was furnished by a local male chorus and other talent, under the direction of Mrs. H. A. Langlie.

All business was suspended for the afternoon and flags were flown at half mast.
