

Dazey Now Has Electric Lights.

Dazey Commercial: The high tension electric line has been tested out the past week, and the current was turned on for the first time. As the current was applied to the line a number of defective insulators were broken. These had to be replaced. Again on Thursday the current was turned on and the street lamps in Dazey were connected up, also the service at the Farmers elevator. The current remained on for several hours and the lamps burned in fine manner, but again defective insulators caused a short circuit in the line and the current was shut off. It is hoped to have the line repaired so that the street lamps in Dazey can burn all night Saturday night. It will probably be a couple of weeks before the line is in shape to supply current permanently and then the services will be connected up just as rapidly as possible.
