Wimbledon Hit By Storm.

The area three miles square with

the city of Wimbledon as the center was hailed out Sunday afternoon. The loss in the Wimbledon area will be about \$50,000 and may reach \$75,000 when the rural districts are heard from. Dazey, 12 miles east of Wimbledon, was not struck, the storm centering its force in the Wimbledon area.

One person was reported to have been injured near Wimbledon. His name could not be ascertained He was riding in an automobile when the storm broke, and sought refuge in a small shed close to the town of Wimbledon. This shed was wrecked by the high wind. Gardens in the Wimbledon district were damaged, and many barns and granaries wrecked. The Harry Drulema barn, two miles north of Wimbledon, was wrecked, according to an early report reaching Wimbledon. There was no stock in the barn at the time.
