

# COUNTY PLANS GOOD ROADS

## COUNTY COMMISSIONERS LET CONTRACT FOR MUCH IM- PROVEMENT IN ROADS

Chairman Otto Pritz was at Cooperstown Wednesday attending a special meeting of the board of county commissioners called for the purpose of considering bids on grad-10 1-2 miles of road west of Cooperstown completing Griggs county's part of the state highway being built from Carrington to Cooperstown and east.

The contract was let to Stanley Bros. and will be completed early next summer. It was intended to have this stretch of road completed in November this fall, but that could not be done.

Two members of the Foster county board also met in Cooperstown the same day and awarded a contract to Stanley Bros. for constructing several miles of road in Foster county, from Glenfield east to the county line completing Foster county's part of the state highway.

When that road is graded another road will be built running north and south through Griggs county. This road will run through Walum, Hannaford, Cooperstown and Binford to the Nelson county line. Surveyors are at work on this proposed road now and work will be started early in the spring.

A large program has been planned by the commissioners for graveling of roads next spring and summer, which promises fair to make the roads in Griggs county some of the best in the state.
