
August Quota To Be Smaller.

North Dakota may be called upon to furnish only 850 men in the August draft call, according to an official announcement in the "Official Bulletin," the government war time newspaper, published in Washington. North Dakota furnished 8,000 men in the July call. Adjutant General Angus Fraser has just completed a survey of the state local draft boards to determine the number of men remaining within Class 1, and many of the counties have only a few men while some did not have a sufficient number of class 1 men to fill the July call. In the August call it is deemed likely that several counties will have to rely upon the new draft list to fill their quotas.
