

New rules for the guidance of automobile drivers and garages went into effect July 1; not a formal order but a request by the government, that all garages close at 6 p. m., remain closed on Sunday, and sell no gasoline after 6 p. m. nor on Sunday, also that private owners make all possible repairs themselves. The object is to release from private work a large number of automobile mechanics, whose service is greatly needed by the army.
