

PLANS MADE FOR 4th BOND DRIVE

Members of County Executive Committee Met in Cooperstown Tuesday Evening.

Griggs county's quota in the 4th Liberty Loan drive, which begins September 28, will be \$335,000.

At a meeting of the executive committee held in Cooperstown on Tuesday evening and presided over by County Chairman Greenland, preliminary plans for the drive were made.

W. G. Schannach was elected secretary to succeed John A. Syverson, who has been called to the colors.

The personal solicitation plan will again be used in Griggs county to raise our quota. But the time of the solicitors can be saved to a large extent if bond buyers will call upon members of the executive committee or upon the district chairman and subscribe for their allotment any time before September 27. Please bear this in mind and do your share to put the 4th Bond drive over in a hurry.
