

VICTORY LOAN IS SUBSCRIBED

Saturday Night Ends Campaign— Griggs County Over With More Townships to Report.

The Victory loan campaign in Griggs county closes Saturday, May 10. To date the county has raised its quota of \$340,000 with \$200 to spare, and no returns having been received from Dover township which has an allotment of \$10,000. The townships of Tyrol, Pilot Mound, Cooperstown, Clearfield, Broadview Washburn and Lenora still have their full quota to raise. These townships are expected to fill their allotment before the close of the campaign Saturday.

There is a possibility that some people have not been seen by the solicitors and in this case they are asked to call on the chairman, or the solicitors in their township or any of the banks and make their purchase.
