

# MORE DRAFT MEN CALLED

## Village Board Resolution.

The village board of trustees call attention to an ordinance adopted in 1914, which prohibits riding bicycles and coasting wagons on the sidewalk: in the village of the Binford, and reads as follows:

Be it ordained by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Binford, Griggs county, North Dakota, that any persons riding bicycles on the sidewalks of said village, and any parent or parents who shall permit or suffer any of their minor children to use children's coasting wagons, for the purpose of coasting on the sidewalks of said village, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of five dollars or be imprisoned in the village jail for a period of five days."

This ordinance will be enforced.
