

PRICES ARE SET FOR THRESHING

Schedule of Prices Was Adopted at
Meeting Held in Cooperstown
Saturday Evening.

Eighteen cents per bushel for wheat, 15 cents for barley and 12 cents for oats is the schedule of prices for threshing grain this season adopted by Griggs county threshermen at the meeting held in Cooperstown Saturday evening. These prices are for grain delivered in tanks, the threshers providing all other labor.

Prices where the threshers provide machines only were set at 7 cents for wheat, 6 for barley and 5 for oats.

A schedule of day fees for the threshing machinery only was adopted as follows:

Outfits with 40-inch cylinder on over, \$85 per day; 36-inch, \$75; 32-inch, \$65, 28-inch or under, \$50.

A committee of nine was elected to set the wage for laborers during the threshing season, and this was fixed at 40c per hour or \$4.50 a day.

After the meeting of the threshermen, a committee of farmers from every section of the county met and adopted a uniform wage scale of \$4.00 per day for harvest help.
