Redeem Your W. S. S. Pledge. The report from headquarters for the sale of War Saving Stamps up to the first of November, shows that there is still over \$45,000, that has not been purchased of the amount pledged in June. Have you bought yours? Surely there can be but few who have disregarded the instructions of the monitors and purchased the stamps outside the county? "Every stamp so purchased is credited to the county where it is bought and Griggs county will fail that much in receiving the proper credit. We are so situated that our county will suffer greatly in this re-

spect unless the purchasers keep this in view. But, undoubtedly the chief reason for the large number of unredeemed pledges is the fact that a great many people have not bought as they pledged. There may be even a few who have not purchased any of their stamps. However, in a county so unmistakably loyal as this it is hard to believe that this is true. In a few weeks the monitors will be furnished copies of the pledges for their district and will call upon you to see what you have done. whole county will be thoroughly canvassed. It would be a wise policy to to prepare for their coming by purchasing the stamps you have pledged if you have not already done so. Even if you are among the number : whose pledge card can not be located, buy the amount you pledged as this is all that is necessary in this final canvass. A copy of every pledge in the county is at county headquarters. You must either have bought or buy the amount pledged in June when the monitor comes to call on you. Now when the dark days are over and glorious victory has come, and the World's New Day has dawned, there is all the more reason to redeem your pledge to the greatest government in the world.
