

REGISTERED MEN CAN ENLIST NOW

Number of Men in Class One Is the
New Basis for County's Quota
—No Call Before Feb. 15.

County quotas for the next contingents to be sent to the training camps will be based on the number of Class 1 men and not on the population of the county as in former drafts.

New quotas will be assigned by the war department to the counties and draft districts before any more men will be sent to the training camps, the old quotas having been wiped out.

Griggs county's former quota was 84 men after deducting the volunteer enlistments prior to the time the quota was assigned. Less than 40 of the quota has been called for to date.

Since the order for classification of registered men was issued and the local board made a recruiting station for the various branches of the service several men have enlisted and Griggs county will be given credit for these men on the next quota.

All sent to the military training camps from now on will be taken from Class 1. The local board has received notice that no call for men for the training camps will be made before February 15. In the meantime the local board is recruiting men for several branches of the army service and any registered man may now get in some branch at any time by applying to the local board.
