

THREE FAILED TO REPORT

Draftees Reported to Adjutant of the Army as Deserters by Local Board.

Sentinel Courier: Three draftees—Sever Garethun, recently of Great Falls, Mont.; Clarence Mellem and Ingvald Anderson, both of St. Paul, Minn., had to be reported by the Local Board as deserters for not responding to their induction orders by appearing.

However, of the three, only one—Sever Garethun—has not been heard from. Mellem wired the board that it was impossible for him to come to Cooperstown, and failed to respond to a wire from the Board to see a Local Board at St. Paul. Ingvald Anderson wrote the Board that he had failed to get his notice on account of a change of manager at his boarding house. He claims to be laid up with an injured knee.

All will have to go to camp, and it will go hard with Garethun if he does not report soon.

The non-appearance of the above-named made it necessary for the Local Board to call three other men and send them. The following were called: Iver Halverson of near Sutton, Carl E. Krantz of Dazey, and Arthur Frank Wonderlich of Fargo. Halverson and Krantz left from here yesterday and Wonderlich was to be sent from Fargo by the Cass county board.

Elmer Oscar Nettetstad, who did not appear to go with the boys from here on the 29th, failed to get his notice in time and the Local Board for Division 4, Duluth, Minnesota, wired for his papers and he was sent from there.
