

The United War Work campaign in this district has been progressing very satisfactorily. All the organized work with the exception of in one township, has been completed, and the result is highly gratifying, exceeding the expectations of the solicitors. The people have responded with a willingness unequaled in former war activities of any sort. The quota for this district, including the townships of Addie, Willow, Bryan, and Rosendal, and the village of Binford, is \$3310. The canvas in Bryan was not finished when The Times went to press, but in all the others the quota has been oversubscribed, and the amount will be increased considerable when complete returns are in.
