

YOUNG MEN TO REGISTER SOON

Local Board Gets Orders to Prepare for Listing Men Who Have Become of Age.

Orders to begin organizing their force for the registration of all men who have become 21 years of age since June 5, 1917, the last registration day, have been received by the local board. The date for this registration has not been set, the bill not having been passed by congress yet, but it is expected to become a law in a few days.

While no definite information as to the procedure to be followed, it is expected by Auditor H. S. Rearick of the local board that registration will be made in the court house this time. Last June the registration was held in each voting precinct.

All men in Griggs county who have become 21 years of age since the last registration day will be required to come to the court house on the day to be set and register as available for military service.

It is believed that every one who registers will be required to fill out and swear to the regular questionnaire. These questionnaires will then be classified by the local and district boards. After the classification is completed all Class 1 men will be ordered to report for physical examination.

As the law now stands, the men to register now will be numbered to follow those registered to date. All available Class 1 men already registered will be called into service first, according to reports from the national capital.
