

Purchased Registered Holsteins.

Sutton Reporter: B. N. Howden and son George received a shipment of registered Holstein cattle Saturday, which were purchased at Faribault, Minnesota. The shipment consisted of cows by name, Aagie Longfield Segis Grahamholm, two years old, and Spofford Ideal Lockspur 2nd, 5 years old. The third animal is a 15 months old bull, Sir Johanna Zelos Homestead which weighed 1050 pounds after being on the road several days. These animals are from ancestry that has produced as much as 30 pounds of butterfat per week official test, and are cattle of fancy breeding. This enterprise of theirs ought to interest the people of this community, for it may lead to the development of a very profitable industry among our farmers.

The names of the animals are given so that those who know anything about the breed will be able to judge their quality.
