W., at Hannaford, last September, will be brought to Fargo to be tried before Judge A. T. Cole in Cass county district court. Attorneys for the defendant had asked that a change of venue be taken from Griggs county to Cass county. Nolan, it is charged, shot Bagley after he had ordered a group of I. W. W.'s to get off the freight train at Hannaford. The men refused to leave the train and Nolan shot, killing Bagley.
