Newspaper Decision Again Delayed A further delay in handing down a decision on the Brinton newspaper grab law which has been before the state supreme court for some time, has resulted through the disqualifications of Judge W. L. Nuessle of the district court, who was asked to review the briefs of Supreme Court Justice Harry A. Bronson. Chief Justice A. M. Christenson announced that no selection had been made of a jurist to fill the vacancy thus created. Another judge will probably be selected this week. The suit was brought by the North Dakota Press association to test the constitutionality of the newspaper law passed by the Nonpartisan league dominated legislature. The action has received close attention from people all over the state as upon the supreme court's ultimate decision the question of
