A commendable piece of road work and worthy of special note is that done by A. H. Overby, from Mose to the Goplen corner just west of town. While Andrew and his boys were laying off waiting to get into the fields, they hitched a drag to Old Henry and did as fine a piece of work as you see anywhere. Now travelers who have gone over the road say that it is just as good as it was any time last summer. The Times calls attention to this that others might emulate the example of Mr. Overby and profit thereby. The deplorable condition of some of the roads leading to Binford might be improved by a few hours of such work.
