

CONCERT BY PEKIN BAND

Great Musical Treat in Store for Binford People Next Thursday Evening.

The Pekin band will render a program of band and orchestra numbers at the opera house, next Thursday evening, and will be assisted by Mrs. C. J. Nerhaugen, of Devils Lake, in several vocal and piano selections.

This announcement will meet with instant favor by music lovers in Binford and surrounding country. Pekin has the distinction of supporting one of the best musical organizations in the state, and while they have been heard by Binford people on various occasions, it has never been our good fortune to hear them in a genuine concert program.

Mr. Nerhaugen, the director, is a musician of rare ability, and as an instructor is rated very high in musical circles. Mr. Nerhaugen lives at Devils Lake and makes weekly trips to Pekin to hold rehearsals. He was just recently engaged to direct the band at that place and since he has taken charge, the boys have made greater progress than ever owing to his capable tutorship and his efficiency as an organizer.

The program consists of 14 numbers, divided into selections by the band, orchestra, duets, vocal and piano solos. After the concert a dance will be given, the music to be furnished by Nerhaugen's orchestra of Devils Lake.

50 cents and 35 cents, and dance tickets will be sold for \$1.00. Supper will be served at Shaw's restaurant.
