

PRITZ HEADS COUNTY BOARD

**Only One Change on Board--B. W.
Hazard Succeeds Lewis Berg in
Second District**

Otto Pritz, of Binford, will head the board of county commissioners for the following year, he having been chosen by the board at its initial meeting of the year, Monday morning.

B. W. Hazard took the oath of office as commissioner in succession to Lewis Berg, and his bond, and those of Commissioners Troseth and Pritz, re-elected, were approved.

Emil Nelson, sheriff-elect, and A. A. Njaa, register of deeds, assumed office with Olger Olsby as Mr. Njaa's deputy.

P. A. Melgard, county auditor-elect, does not assume his office until April.
