

## JOHN ERDAHL CALLED TO GREAT BEYOND

McVie Journal: John Erdahl, one of the pioneer residents of the community, passed away at the Community Hospital last Friday morning following a short attack of heart trouble.

Mr. Erdahl was 50 years of age, having been born in Pope county, Minnesota, October 26, 1870. He came to North Dakota in 1896 and has been prominently identified with the affairs of this community since that time.

Funeral services were held at the McVie Lutheran church, Wednesday morning, and at the Norway Lutheran church in the afternoon, interment being made at the cemetery at that place. Rev. H. O. Bach officiated on both occasions, and the pall bearers were A. O. Moen, Stener Stenson, Harris Oakland, Albert Oakland, Ole Skinde, and Peter Odegard.

Mr. Erdahl was a good man in every meaning that the word implies. He was a lovable character and won the esteem and friendship of those with whom he came in contact, and always gave liberally of both time and money toward the affairs of the community and the church of which he was a member.
