

NELSON COUNTY PIONEER ANSWERS FINAL CALL

Gudmund Gudmundson passed away on Tuesday afternoon at 4:30 o'clock, at his home fifteen miles northwest of Binfere. He had been in poor health for several years but had been up and around as usual until about two weeks before death came to relieve him from suffering. Death was caused by cancer of the liver.

Gudmund Gudmundson was born in Storo, Bergen, Norway, on Sept. 16, 1854, and had reached the age of 69 years, 4 months and 26 days. He was married in Norway to Miss Martha Taraldstad, and some time later emigrated to America with his wife and infant child in 1884, coming to Nelson county where he took a homestead, which has been their home since. To this union five children were born, two of whom are deceased. The children are Martin, of Brainerd, Minnesota; Mrs. Gina Tweed, of near Tolna; Thea, who passed away shortly before the holidays last year; Mrs. Mary Tweed, of near Tolna, and a twin brother who died in infancy. Mrs. Gudmundson also survives and mourns the death of a loving husband and kind father.

Mr Gudmundson was active in church work, being one of the first to found the church near his home. He was always ready and willing to lend a helping hand to those who were in need of anything within his power to help. He will be greatly missed by his family, neighbors and the church.

Funeral services will be held from the home on Friday afternoon at 1 o'clock.
