

# YOUNG MAN PASSES AWAY AT DUNSEITH

Roy Iverson, son of Nils Iverson, of Brooten, Minnesota, passed away suddenly Friday, December 1, at a sanatorium at Dunseith, from a hemorrhage. He had been ailing for some time and went to Dunseith two weeks ago to seek relief. His death causes much sorrow in this community where he was so well known and where he has made his home for so many years.

Deceased was born in Brooten, Minnesota, on January 25, 1896, later moving to a farm west of Binford with his parents. His mother has been deceased many years, but he leaves to mourn, his father, four brothers, Ernest and Clarence, at Brooten; Leonel, of California; Herbert, South Dakota; and a sister, Myrtle, of Brooten.
