

MRS. MIKAL MOGAARD

PASSES AWAY SATURDAY

Mrs. Emma Mogaard, 51, of Revere, died at 7:40 p. m. Saturday, in a Fargo hospital.

The funeral was held from the family home near Revere, Tuesday, at 1 p. m., with services at the Mabel Lutheran church at 3 p. m. Rev. George S. Natwick was in charge and burial was made in the Mabel church cemetery.

Mrs. Mogaard was born in Goodhue county, Minn., March 7, 1872, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Hans Bordson, and was married to Mikal Mogaard there in November, 1899. They came to Griggs county three years later.
