

ANDREW NERBY DROPS DEAD

McHenry Tribune: This community was shocked today (Thursday) when word reached town that Andrew Nerby was found dead about a mile and a half east of town.

He was on his way to town in his big Hupmobile and in crossing the grade near the Swanson home, about a mile and a half east of town, when the rear wheels skidded out of the track and would not go back into the track. Alone, he had managed to carry grass and weeds and place under the rear wheels and had moved the car about a hundred yards in this manner. He evidently had worked pretty hard or might have pushed or lifted on the car and overexerted himself, and at his advanced age of 67 years, and was overcome.

Mr. Nerby was a pioneer of this community and a splendid specimen of manhood, and his unexpected demise brought deepest sorrow to the people of the community.
