
Death of Mrs. Andrew Reid

Sanborn Enterprise: Mrs. Andrew Reid of Moorhead, better known in Sanborn as Mrs. McChesney, notice of whose sickness and going to Bismarck in care of her youngest daughter, Alice, is given elsewhere in this issue of The Enterprise, died the next morning after reaching Bismarck, we are informed. The family formerly lived in Sanborn.

Mrs. Andrew Reid was a pioneer Dakotan, and in the early days of the settlement of the territory was always on the frontier, her first husband, we believe, being in some way connected with the regular army. With her mother she was at Fort Seward (now Jamestown) and it is said that her son, Will McChesney, who died a year or two ago, was the first white child born there.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 p. m. from the First Presbyterian church at Moorhead, Tuesday, April 6, 1921. Rev. W. J. Hall officiated. Interment took place in Riverside cemetery.
