Wm. Boyle received a message conveying the sad news of the death of a niece, Merlin Sawdy, in an automobile accident, and left Thursday for Royalton, Minnesota, to attend the funeral. The victim was sixteen years old and, with six others, all high school students except the driver, were on their way to attend a basket ball game between Upsala and Royalton at Upsala. Miss Sawdy was killed, another probably fatally injured, two seriously hurt and three others slightly injured when an oil truck they were riding in, overturned, two miles west of Royalton. Another student is in a critical condition in the hospital, suffering from a blow on the head and gasoline burns.
