

Life Insurance Company Makes Prompt Payment

The Great Northern Life Insurance Company of Grand Forks, paid a death claim yesterday in the sum of \$8,000, to Annie Anderson, wife of the deceased, Ole O. Anderson, who died last Friday evening.

The company's local representative, C. E. Peterson, informed the head office of Mr. Anderson's death last Saturday morning. The necessary papers showing proof of death were filled out Tuesday, and a draft for the amount of the policy was delivered to the beneficiary the following day. This prompt action on the part of the company is sure to be appreciated.

The policy carried by Mr. Anderson was written on a ten-year term plan, a form similar to that which was written the soldier boys during the war. The premium is very low, in the case of Mr. Anderson it being \$145.04 per year for the \$8,000. Mr. Peterson wrote this application in October, 1920.
