

The electric fire alarm purchased by the Binford Fire department was put to trial Tuesday forenoon and was distinctly heard in all parts of the town. The siren was shipped on thirty days' trial and will be given a thorough tryout under all conditions before it is accepted. It is a single head model and is controlled by a switch. The siren starts slowly and the sound is a heavy roar, and as the motor gains in speed the siren notes grow higher and higher until, at maximum speed, it is a shrill, powerful shriek.
