

POSTMASTER SAYS FARMERS MUST CUT WEEDS ON ROUTES

Postmaster J. A. Knapp wishes to call attention of the farmers to the fact that they are neglecting to keep up the roads on the mail routes, and also that they are permitting the growth of obnoxious weeds along the sides of the roads and around the mail boxes.

Mr. Knapp says there is a postal ruling which permits the carriers to refuse service to any place where roads are difficult to pass over, or where the mail boxes are obstructed in any manner by weeds, snow, or any other obstacle.
