
CHEAPER RATE FOR EMIGRANTS

To further encourage the upbuilding and development of the great Northwest, the Northern Pacific R. R. company has announced sharply reduced carload freight rates on household and farm goods from eastern points to North Dakota and Montana. The reductions average about 40 per cent and are effective April 10.

There have been no special rates of this kind for emigrant movables since 1918.

The new tariff will permit the carrying in emigrant cars of one second hand automobile for each car. This establishes an entirely new precedent. Heretofore, buggies, wagons, horses and some farm animals have been included in emigrant shipments but motor cars have been barred.

By this order the comparison between present rates and the special rates for emigrants from Minneapolis and St. Paul to Fargo makes a difference of 10c, the new rate being 14½c and the present rate 24½c.
